RE: Convention Voting Rights

The Constitution of Delta Sigma Phi is very specific on who may vote at the Convention and how those voting rights must be certified. *Please read this memo very carefully and be sure to respond accordingly.*

UNDERGRADUATE CHAPTERS AND COLONIES

- Chapters in *good standing* with 50 or fewer members (initiates and pledges) are eligible for one vote. Chapters in *good standing* with more than 50 members are eligible for 2 votes. Colonies in *good standing*, regardless of size, receive one-half vote. All delegates must be certified.
- Delegates **MUST** complete and submit the appropriate attached certification form by June 20, 2007.

Good standing means:

- All pledges must be reported and pledge fees paid.
- All initiates must be reported and initiation fees paid.
- Chapter/colony must have a zero balance with the Headquarters.
- Any chapter/colony having a loan with the Headquarters must be current with payments in accordance with repayment schedule.
- Chapters/colonies on probation or suspension must have disciplinary status lifted prior to the Convention.
