Culture: Describe your experiences in matters of culture that includes (but not limited to): the visual and performing arts, journalism and letters, athletics, and other cultural areas.

Harmony: Describe your experiences in the matters of leadership, student government, other student or equivalent organizations, community service and working to better society. How have you made a difference to others?

Friendship: Describe your experiences in Delta Sigma Phi both as a brother and friend to others. Describe how you have made a difference in Delta Sigma Phi and how Delta Sigma Phi has made a difference to you. How have you “Paid the Debt?”

Need: Describe your reasons why the scholarship is needed, including a reference to other ways in which you are providing for your college education or will provide for graduate school.
