Application Instructions and FAQs

Basic Requirements:

1. A proven record of campus and community involvement
2. At the time of attendance, have completed two full years of college and be returning to school the following year
3. Member of Delta Sigma Phi in good standing

Application Deadlines: Applicants meeting the early admission deadline of March 12 will be notified of their status by March 26. Applicants who send in their materials between March 13 and the final deadline of April 9 will be notified by April 23.

Academic Transcript: An official or unofficial copy of your academic transcript must accompany your application. At many colleges and universities, transcripts can be found on the institution's web site.

Recommendations: Two recommendation forms should accompany your application. Recommendations should be from individuals who can objectively speak to your leadership abilities: employers, professors, advisors, coaches, etc.—**not other undergraduates or family members.**

Review of Applications: A selection committee of alumni members will review the applications. Applicants will be scored strictly on the merit of their applications.
