Application Instructions and FAQs

Basic Requirements: 1. A proven record of campus and community involvement. 2. At the time of attendance, have completed two full years of college and still be an undergraduate. 3. Member of Delta Sigma Phi in good standing.

Application Deadlines: Applicants' deadline for admission is March 24th. Applicants will be notified no later than April 21st.

Academic Transcript: An official or unofficial copy of your academic transcript must accompany your application. At many colleges and universities, transcripts can be found on the institution's web site.

Recommendations: Two recommendation forms should accompany your application. Recommendations should be from individuals who can objectively speak to your leadership abilities: employers, professors, university administrators, advisors, coaches, etc.—**not other undergraduates or family members.**

Review of Applications: A selection committee of alumni members will review the applications. Applicants will be scored strictly on the merit of their applications.

What if I have a summer job/internship or class? Definitely apply! Many employers/instructors will allow, or even encourage, you to attend the LI because of the professional development opportunities the program provides; just be sure to let them know as soon as possible. The Fraternity Staff will provide you with a letter detailing the Leadership Institute that you can share with your employer from Executive Director, Scott Wiley.

How many applicants will be accepted? The maximum capacity is 70 participants.
