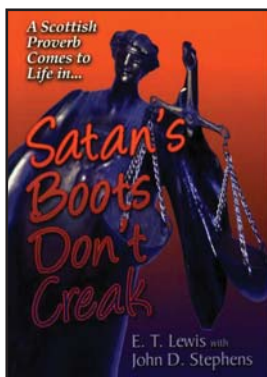


SATAN'S BOOTS DON'T CREAK

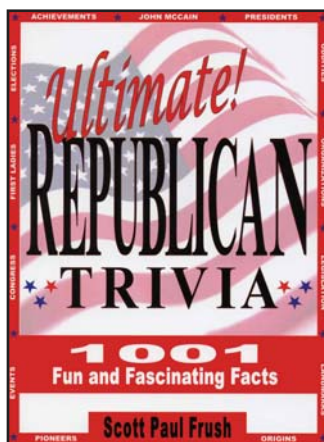
