## About This Component

Chapters can provide a benefit to their community beyond service. The Campus Forums component encourages chapters to build relationships with their local or college/university community by hosting events that provide value to all students.

## Best Practices

- Many professors host forums, roundtables or panel discussions throughout the year. Ask if your chapter can host one of these discussions and offer to promote the event to the student body or other organizations.
- Co-Hosting a career fair may be a great way to get alumni members involved and to show off one of any fraternity's greatest selling points: connections which can help build a student's future.
- Assist your Fraternity/Sorority Life or equivalent office in hosting a speaker. Members can volunteer to help prepare the program and the chapter can offer to sponsor or subsidize costs related to the speaker.
