## About This Component

The policy of the Fraternity, and our adherence to it, directly affect the cost of membership as well as the reputation of the Fraternity and a chapter's good standing with its host institution.

## Best Practices

- Be sure to educate all members on the Fraternity's policies.
- Require all new members to participate in GreekLifeEdu as is required by the National Fraternity (as of spring 2016). This program covers topics specifically related to fraternities and addressing hazing, alcohol and sexual assault.
- Learn from missteps when they are made and make changes to prevent them from occurring again. It is ineffective to complete sanctions or a probationary period without making an effort to change what got the chapter into a disciplinary position in the first place.
